



A Randomised Controlled Trial of sildenafil therapy In Dismal Prognosis Early-Onset Intrauterine Growth Restriction

Dear colleagues

The STRIDER UK trial is continuing to recruit well with 50 women now randomised. It is reassuring to note that these participants have come from nearly all the centres that are open. However, we would encourage you to seek out these rare patients and approach them for inclusion so that we can maintain this excellent degree of progress towards trial completion.

Can we remind everyone that data entry for the STRIDER trial may be different from what is recorded as part of standard clinical care, and we would encourage all of you to look very closely at the CRF to ensure that you are recording the right information at the right points during the study.

We will be sending out data discrepancy reports to each unit that has recruited over the next few weeks. These are not designed to be critical but just to ensure that we get as much information recorded from this extremely valuable cohort and we are able to give as full a picture as possible of the effects of sildenafil in IUGR.

The discrepancy report will be a list of missing or queried data listed for each randomised participant. If data can be found can it then be filled in, but if data is unavailable and not going to become available then I would ask that you write NA in the comments on REDCAP for that particular query. We can then review these and close the data discrepancy report so it doesn't continue to flag up as unfilled.

When the data queries arrive we would ask all PIs and their teams to do their utmost to hunt out any data that is missing.

We are now putting the finishing touches to the 2+ year follow up of these children, which is essential to ensure safety and efficacy of sildenafil treatment.
